

HOW TO PLACE FLOATING CANDLES

NOTICE: Extra care is required in positioning candles in glassware and vases. Full replacement cost will be charged for any items returned cracked.





- Do not allow water level to drop less than ½" below the top of the glass when using water to float candles. Glassware will crack if a lit candle is allowed to drift under or too near the glass.
- If you want the candle lower than $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the top, use gel crystals to hold candles directly below the mouth of the glassware.

CANDLE CARE

- Never leave a burning candle unattended.
- · Keep lighted candles out of the reach of children and pets.
- · Avoid burning candles near combustible materials.
- Keep wicks trimmed to 1/2" or less. Long or crooked wicks cause uneven burning and dripping.
- Candles refrigerated before using will burn more slowly and evenly. Wrap in foil or plastic before refrigeration to prevent wicks from absorbing moisture.
- Extinguish candles when they get within 2" of their holders or decorations.
- If a wick becomes too short to light, carve away enough wax to expose the fresh wick, then trim ¼" off the top of the candle and burn the candle to reform its appearance.
